Original Bylaw #: Bylaw 7.3	New Bylaw # (if applicable):
Proposed Revised Policy: 7.3 Departmental representatives 7.3.1 The number of Representatives per Department shall be as follows: (a) All departments (as defined in 2.1 1.3), regardless of size, are entitled to appoint one council member. That council member must be appointed in an open and democratic election; and	
Rationale Behind Proposed Changes: Currently, Bylaw 7.3.1.a refers to Bylaw 2.1 for a definition of “departments”; however, this definition does not exist in 2.1 (Procedure and effect) but rather in 1.3 (Departmental representation). This change is to update the reference existing in the Bylaws.
